
## Ricky Pfeil Comments

**1 Peter 4:11, If any man speak, let him speak as the oracles of God.** Another version of the Bible says **“Those who preach must preach God's messages.”** The word “oracles” means “in accordance with the truth which God has revealed”, according to commentator Albert Barnes. With that in mind, I want to quote some statements in an “Open Letter To Pastors and Christians” from Pastor Shane Idleman who is pastor of a church in California.

*“The pulpit regulates the spiritual condition of God’s people which affects the nation. A lukewarm, sex-saturated culture (and church) simply reflects the lack of conviction in the pulpit as well as the pew.*

*Sadly, many pastors are exchanging truth for passivity, boldness for cowardliness, and conviction for comfort...they are not aflame with righteousness. We aim to be motivational speakers rather than preachers of righteousness.*

*Pastors (and Christian leaders alike) must take responsibility for the spiritual health of today’s church, and the nation. We don’t need more marketing plans, demographic studies, or giving campaigns; we need men filled with the Spirit of God. Pastors, we are not just cheerleaders, we*




*are game changers. We are called to stir and to convict so that change takes place.”*

As we see an increase in the flood of debauchery, barbarism, and moral filthiness coming from politicians since the November elections, it behooves us to be preachers such as Pastor Idleman describes in his letter. When a state legislation in New York legalizes infanticide (abortion right up to the moment of birth), and when a state governor talks about an infant being born with a discussion ensuing with the father and mother and doctor about helping it live or distinguishing its life, and when the left supports such things as these, and government-controlled health care for all Americans, should we continue just preaching short non-controversial sermons that

don’t say much with substance, or will we rise up like a mighty army and lift up our voices like a trumpet to speak as the messenger of God with a bold confrontational message, calling on people to repent?

If the boldness and blatant anti-God and anti-Biblical wickedness being thrust upon us, including the LGBT agenda, and the attacks on Christian schools, etc., isn’t enough to call us to action and prayer and repentance, what will it take? If not now, when? If not us, who? If not here, where?
